A normal range is  $800 \text{ to } 1200 \text{ dynes} \cdot \text{sec} / \text{cm}^5$ . The systemic vascular resistance index (SVRI) is then calculated with the formula:  $80 \times (\text{MAP} - \text{RAP}) / \text{CI}$ . Normal range for SVRI (systemic vascular resistance index) is  $1970 \text{ to } 2390 \text{ dynes} \cdot \text{sec} / \text{cm}^5 / \text{m}^2$ .
